



# Reducing alcohol harm in the Chin community through sport

## Chin Community Leader Feedback Pre-Survey

In July 2019 a surface upgrade was conducted at Hughes Park Community facility in North Croydon which is home to the Australian Chin Community. Pre-surface upgrade surveys of 23 leaders from the Chin community were conducted online, with survey questions received and then translated from Hakha Chin to English. n = 23.

### How is the court being used?

60%

Of respondents use the court for Sport

40%

Of respondents use the court for community development & friendship



On average, 20+ people use the court at a time.

The court is currently used 2 to 3 times each week

### Identified risks with the current court condition?



82%

of respondents mentioned the potential for injury or risk to safety, with the current condition of the courts



### All respondents indicated that they expect positive outcomes from the upgrade.

*"I believe that it will bring forth a range of developments and health benefits (well-beings) for us, the youth"*

Expected benefits to the overall community

*"I think it will help our friendship within the community to be maintained and strengthened."*

### Anticipated use for the upgraded facility

60% Sport

*"We will use it for sports at day times and for entertainment in the evening and at weekends"*

32% improved community engagement

*"It will be very useful for youth friendship & engagement, activities and church related picnic"*

8% Other

*"It will be used for gaining development, enjoyment, health and best friendship"*
